2023-2024 Estimated Cost of Attendance and Financial Aid

Applicants needing federal and institutional financial assistance to help with the cost of attending a school or program at UMB must complete the **Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA)**. Please note:

- USFA strongly encourages completing the FAFSA at studentaid.gov no later than March 1st for priority consideration.
UMB School Code: **002104**
- The 2023-2024 FAFSA covers the 2023-2024 Academic Year (Summer 2023, Fall 2023 and Spring 2024).
- Students must complete a FAFSA for every academic year they wish to receive assistance.

Estimated Cost of Attendance

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is the maximum amount of financial assistance available to a student in one academic year. The COA is determined using each student's enrollment and residency classification (Resident or Non-Resident). For the DPT program, tuition is charged per credit. The tuition in the COA is based upon enrollment of 45 credits between the summer, fall, and spring semesters.

**Living expenses are based on off-campus housing which includes University Suites at Fayette Square. For students living in Pascault Row, living expenses total \$ 28,920. For students living with parents, living expenses are \$ 14,100.*

Applicants are awarded 100% of the Cost of Attendance with assistance from federal and institutional resources.
